Guest Registration

We encourage you to bring a guest to the meeting. (For registration purposes, a guest is a nonhistorian or nonteacher who would not otherwise attend the meeting except to accompany the attendee.) Guests receive a convention badge that allows them to attend sessions and offsite events.

One-Day Registration

Attendees who choose to register for one day will receive a badge indicating the date for which they are registered, and will receive access to the sessions and offsite events on that day. One-day registration is available onsite only.

Georgia State University's University Village Apartments

Conference attendees have the option of staying in the Sparta building in GSU's University Village apartments. The majority of the apartments at the University Village include four single bedrooms, two baths, and small kitchens. Bedrooms are furnished with single beds, full-size closets, and dressers. Linens, including one pillow, two towels, a face cloth, two bed sheets, a blanket, and a pillow case are provided. Kitchens include refrigerators, microwaves and telephones. GSU does not allow men and women to house in the same apartment unless they are married, and children are not allowed to house in the apartments. Check-in times are from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily. Parking is available at the apartments for \$5.00 per day. Apartment rooms are \$37.00 per night per person with linen. Register for housing by May 21 on the preregistration form on page 30 or online.

Directions to the GSU University Village Apartments

From the north: Traveling southbound on I-75/85, take Exit 249 (Williams Street/ Georgia Dome), turn west at the first traffic light onto Alexander Street. At the first traffic light turn right onto Centennial Olympic Park Place. Proceed north on Centennial Olympic Park Place to the GSU University Village. Identify yourself as an OAH attendee at the intercom. Parking is available in the deck to your right. Enter the building directly opposite the entrance of the parking deck.

From the south: Traveling northbound on I-75/85, take Exit 249D (Peachtree Street/ Spring Street). Once on the exit bear to the right and stay in the right lane. This lane proceeds under I-75/85 to Centennial Olympic Park Place. Turn right on Centennial Olympic Park Place. Proceed to the GSU University Village. Identify yourself as an OAH attendee at the intercom. Parking is available in the deck to your right. Enter the building directly opposite the entrance of the parking deck.

MARTA: Take either the North Springs train or the Doraville train north to the N3 or North Avenue stop. Exit onto North Avenue and walk west to the GSU University Village. At the entrance gate, use the security telephone to identify yourself as an OAH attendee.

Country Inn & Suites Downtown

A limited number of hotel rooms have been reserved for conference attendees at the Country Inn & Suites Downtown at Turner Field. The hotel is located south of downtown Atlanta, directly across from Turner Field—home of the Atlanta Braves. Each guest room offers in-room coffee, full-size ironing boards, and hair dryers. The hotel offers a deluxe continental breakfast each morning with pastries, waffles, pancakes, muffins and more. Parking at the Country Inn & Suites Downtown is complimentary for guests.

Directions to the Country Inn & Suites Downtown

I-75/85 North—Exit 245. Turn left onto Pollard Boulevard. The hotel is on the left. I-75/85 South—Exit 246. Left onto Fulton Street, right onto Capitol Avenue, right onto Abernathy Boulevard, left onto Pollard Boulevard.

I-20 East—Exit 56B. Turn right onto Windsor, left onto Fulton Street, right onto Capitol Avenue, right onto Abernathy Boulevard, left onto Pollard Boulevard. I-20 West—Exit 58A. Turn left onto Capitol Avenue, right onto Abernathy Boulevard, left onto Pollard Boulevard.

Reservations

All hotel reservations must be accompanied by a first night room deposit or secured with a major credit card. Guest rooms are available at the OAH conference rate: \$85.00 per night plus tax, which is currently 14%. To reserve a room, please contact the hotel directly and be sure to mention the OAH meeting. **Deadline for reservations is June 8, 2004.**

Directions to the GSU Student/University Center

Driving

I-75/I-85 Northbound—Exit # 246 (Central Avenue/Fulton Street). Follow the signs to Fulton Street. At the light at the end of the ramp, turn right on Fulton. At the next light, turn left on Capitol Avenue. After crossing MLK Jr. Drive, Capitol Avenue becomes Piedmont Avenue and passes through campus. The Student/University Center is on the corner of Piedmont Avenue and Gilmer Street.

I-75/I-85 Southbound—Exit # 249A (Courtland Street) is a one-way street which leads to the campus. From Courtland Street, turn right onto Gilmer Street. The Student/University Center is on the corner of Piedmont Avenue and Gilmer Street.

I-20 Eastbound—Exit # 56B (Windsor/Spring Street), go straight to the third traffic light. Take a left on Central Avenue. From Central Avenue, turn right onto Gilmer Street. The Student/University Center is on the corner of Piedmont Avenue and Gilmer Street.

I-20 Westbound—Exit # 58A (Capitol Avenue) and turn right at the light. Stay on Capitol which changes into Piedmont Avenue. The Student/University Center is on the corner of Piedmont Avenue and Gilmer Street.

MARTA

Take the east/west line to the Georgia State station. Exit the station onto Piedmont Avenue. Turn right and walk two blocks to Gilmer Street (you will cross Decatur Street). Enter the Student/University Center at the corner of Gilmer and Piedmont.

Taxi

A cab ride to the Student University Center from the airport will cost between \$25.00 and \$35.00. Add \$2.00 to the fare for each additional rider.
